The Academy is in the idyllic setting affording best possible educational facilities to the children of Punjab coming from different backgrounds and cross section with distinctive accent on providing these facilities to the rural population and those belonging to the Armed Forces, Para Military and Police forces. This dream of the visionaries of the State became a reality on September 24, 1978 when Shri N. Sanjeeva Reddy, the then President of India laid the foundation stone of the Academy. The Academy started functioning from July, 1980. Since then the Academy has grown in strength and reputation.

The site of the Academy extends over 163 acres of undulating picturesque area located 5 Kms east of the historical Gurudwara Takhat Sri Keshgarh Sahib. Sri Naina Devi Temple with its own sublimity stands as being sentinel over the area suffusing the air with spiritual serenity.

EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY & OBJECTIVES

Sri Dasmesh Academy is concerned with the education of all its pupils. It stresses upon the ethos of striving for excellence and takes pride in the achievements of all its students. The Academy aims at the following objectives:-

- (a) Lead through excellence in academics, culture, sports and social services.
- (b) To create among the students a strong sense of duty, discipline and values.
- (c) To develop qualities of leadership and to equip the students for high positions in life in various fields.
- (d) To help the students develop an integrated personality with a capacity to adjust in varying situations.
- (e) To develop in the students spiritual and moral values and to create awareness of our cultural heritage.
- (f) To provide adequate facilities in sports and out door activities and to enable the students to excel at national and international levels.
- (g) Special emphasis is laid to prepare the students for entry to NDA for which extra coaching is held from the commencement of the session.

CURRICULUM

The Academy is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi for All India Secondary School Examination (Class X) and All India Senior School Certificate Examination (Class XII),. The medium of instructions is English, yet Hindi and Punjabi are given equal emphasis upto Class X. At+ 2 level we offer Medical, Non Medical and Commerce streams to the students.

ADMISSIONS

Admissions to the Academy are made purely on merit through competitive process of written test and counseling held on Third / Last Sunday of January every year. Admission is open to all Indian nationals. 5% seats are reserved for the Indians settled abroad (NRIs). The main intake is in Class Illrd. However in other classes the admissions are offered depending on availability of vacancies.

FEE & OTHER CHARGES

The details of Fee and other charges are attached as appx 'A'. Wards of Defence Forces, Para Military forces and Police Forces personnel are given a concession in the fee as per the attached statement of the fee structure according to their ranks.

The fee is required to be paid on quarterly basis. The fee of each quarter must be paid by 10th of April, July, October, and January failing which late fee @ Rs. 200/- per week will be charged. Name of the student will be struck off the roll if the fee is not deposited by 30th of these months and the student shall have to seek readmission by paying Rs. 2000/- i.e admission fee. (The fee is however subject to revision without any notice keeping in view the increased price index.

Note: Fees shall be deposited with Oriental Bank of Commerce Anandpur Sahib Distt. Ropar (Punjab) in Sri Dasmesh Academy, Anandpur Sahib A/c No. 08792191002513 IFSC Code. ORBC0100879. Out station parents can remit payment through bank draft/online Bank Transfer in favour of "Principal, Sri Dasmesh Academy, Ananpur Sahib". Cheque is not acceptable.

Caution money must be claimed within one year of the student leaving the academy failing which the same will be forfeited.

REGISTRATION

Registration for admission starts in December every year. The students are required to register their names for the admission test. Registration Fee of Rs. 1000/(Non-refundable) should be remitted through a crossed Bank Draft from any Bank in favour of 'SRI DASMESH ACADEMY' payable at Anandpur Sahib or payable in cash at the Academy Counter along with the Application Form.



The following documents are required to be attached alongwith the Application Form;

- 1. Birth Certificate from any of the followings:
 - (a) Head of the institution last attended subject to the satisfaction of the Director.
 - (b) The Chief Medical Officer of the District.
 - (c) The Registrar of Births and Deaths.
 - (d) An extract from Part-II order in the case of Armed Forces and Para-Military forces personnel.

DAY SCHOLARS

The Academy admits day scholars, both boys and girls, from surrounding areas. Transport to the day scholars to bring them to the Academy and drop them back has been arranged on contract basis on payment with the Bus Contractors. Availability of transport is subject to the availability of seats in the bus to avoid overloading. Detail of bus fee can be obtained from the account branch.

OVERSEAS STUDENTS

The parents of the overseas students must ensure that the travel documents are completed in all respects. They are required to hand over the following papers relating to their wards in the Academy Office on arrival

- a) Passport valid for one year
- (b) Visa valid for at least one year
- (c) Health Certificate



ADMISSION TEST

Children whose names are registered for admission upto Class VIII will be required to appear for counseling. For admission in Class IX and XI, the applicant will be required to appear for an Admission Test in (a) Mathematics (b) English. It will be followed by an interview by a Selection Committee. Merit alone shall be the criteria to qualify an individual for admission.

NDA TRAINING WING

NDA Training Wing in the Academy has been set up to impart training to join Defence Forces as an Officer through National Defence Academy. Under this scheme admission is done in Class XI for those students who wish to join Defence Forces after passing Class XII. The admission will be done purely on merit basis and the students has to appear in a Written Entrance Test (English, Maths and G.K. of Xth standard) and interview. All other students of Class XI and XII desirous of joining Defence Forces will also be trained for joining NDA.

Eligibility Criteria: The student should be (a) Domicile of Punjab (b) Should be medically fit as per the requirement of the NDA (c) Appearing in Class X examination (d) Date of birth should be as given in the advertisement at the time of admission.

AGE

Class age relationship norm is given below:

Class III Age as on 31st March of the year of admission 7 to 8½ years.

Other classes Class+4 to 5 ½ years.

(For example, if one who would like to seek admission in Class VI then the age of the child should be 6 + 4 to $5\frac{1}{2}$ years, that is between 10 years to 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ years)

Parents/guardians are advised not to withdraw their wards from their previous school till intimation of admission is received.

FINANCES

Limited Scholarships/subsidy to the wards of Defence Force, Para-Military and Police Forces personnel is met out of the interest accruing from the Endowment Fund created by the Punjab Defence & Security Relief Fund Committee from time to time.

WITHDRAWAL

In case of withdrawal of the student after admission, he/she is required to give one month's notice. Fee and annual charges of the entire quarter i.e. three months will be forfeited if a student's withdrawn during the terms i.e.

- (i) April to June (iii) October to December
- (ii) July to September (iv) January to March

The Management can, in the interest of the Academy, ask the parents to withdraw a student for the following reasons:

- (i) Where in the opinion of the Principal/Director, the student has failed to comply with the discipline of the Academy and his/ her continued presence is detrimental to the interest of the others.
- (ii) Where the student fails to come up to the Academic standard of his/her class. This provision is made in the interest of the student so that he/she may leave the Academy when he/she is still young enough to make good in a school more suitable for him/her.

LEAVE FOR STUDENT

Boarders can avail leave which is authorized by the Academy Calendar. No leave other than authorized leave will be granted except on compassionate grounds / emergency.

STAFF

The teaching staff is the most important resource of any school. A team of dedicated, qualified and capable teachers are drawn from among the best from all parts of the country. The teacher student ratio is 1:25.



HOUSE SYSTEM

The students on the Academy roll are divided into three houses, BEAS, RAVI and SUTLEJ, named after the famous rivers of Punjab. Each House is supervised by a House Master assisted by a House Executive and a Matron residing in the same block. All other teachers are also attached to either of the Houses to assist the House Masters.

Inter House Competitions such as Debates, Declamations, Quiz, Sports, Games and Cultural activities are held as a regular feature.



ROUTINE

Students in the boarding follow a strict routine starting with Morning P.T., Prep, Breakfast, General Assembly, Classes, Remedial Classes / Spoken English Class, Games and Evening prep till lights out at nights. Prep time is used for preparation for examinations and completing the homework. Hobby classes and extra tutorials are held for the weak students during the afternoon hours. Games are compulsory for all the boarders.

GAMES & SPORTS

The Academy has well maintained playing fields for various games viz. Hockey, Football, Cricket, Basketball, Lawn Tennis, Table Tennis, Badminton, Volleyball, Athletics. The Academy has 400 meters cinder track, rubberized international standard Tennis and Badminton Courts a full-fledged stadium and a gymnasium and International standard Swimming Pool.

The Academy has been actively participating in Inter School Sports. We are regularly participating in the IPSC / CBSE tournaments in various disciplines in which teams of all over India participate.



CURRICULAR & CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-curricular activities go a long way in developing all round personality of students. These activities are part of Academy curriculum as per CBSE norms. Co-curricular activities such as music, drawing and painting, clay modelling, electronic, gardening and horticulture are conducted on a regular feature. Trekking & excursions are also undertaken to develop a sense of adventure amongst the students.



NCC : NCC is compulsory for all boys & girls of the Academy from Classes VIII to X preparing them for "A" certificate examination.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The Academic block is equipped with Modern Smart Classes, Laboratories/ workshop, well stocked Library, Computer Lab, Language Lab and common assembly area to accommodate approx. 1000 students. The administrative infrastructure includes spacious, well-lit and airy separate boys and girls hostels with central study rooms and entertainment rooms, the Academy Mess, International standard sports facilities to include 400 meters athletics track, international standard Basket Ball courts, Tennis courts and indoor Badminton courts. It also has a 20 bed Infirmary with full time Pharmacist and Doctor to provide medical cover to the students.





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Smart classes- Education through digital media are provided to the students to make the learning more interactive, interesting and effective.

GIRLS HOSTEL

Girls are admitted in the Academy as Boarders and Day Boarders. For the Boarder girls, there is a well established separate girls hostel. The girls are being looked after by a qualified House Mistress. Girls can be admitted to all classes from Class III to IX & XI. They follow the same routine as the boys.

BAND

The Academy has a School Band that participates in all important functions at Anandpur Sahib and are frequently requisitioned by the local administration.

All boys /girls of classes XI and XII are the member of National Social Service Scheme.

ACADEMY LIBRARY

The Academy has a well stocked Computerized Library constructed on modern lines covering all subjects of knowledge. We subscribe to all the important and leading newspapers and magazines such as India Today, Time, Sports Star, Competition Success Review, Readers' Digest, Economic Times, The Hindustan Times etc. The students are encouraged to develop a healthy reading habit. The Library remains open during Sundays and vacations.









MEDICAL

We have a 20 bed, 24 hour infirmary under the control of a Medical Officer, who is assisted by a qualified Medical Assistant. Specialists are consulted where necessary. Medical Reports are sent home annually.

THE ACADEMY MULTIPURPOSE OPERA HOUSE

The Academy has a multipurpose high roof hall reminiscent of the Sydney Opera House, an architectural gem. It has an indoor seating capacity of 1000. It has a Basketball, a Badminton court and Table Tennis Tables to ensure games activities even during bad weather.

It also has a stage and green room for cultural activities. It comprises of a well equipped gymnasium for body building and health club.

SPORTS COMPLEX

The Academy has full fledged Sports Complex having well maintained 16 playing fields for various games, viz, Hocky, Football, Cricket, Basketball, Lawn Tennis, Table Tennis, Badminton, Volleyball, Athletics. The Academy has 400 meters cinder track, rubberized international standard Tennis and Badminton Courts a full fledged stadium and a Gymnasium.

SWIMMING POOL

The Academy has a Swimming Pool of International standard having indoor Badminton, Table Tennis, Gym and indoor Shooting Range along with this.





AUDITORIUM

The Academy has Air Conditioned Auditorium having seating capacity 600. This is being used for celebrating all the functions conducted in the Academy from time to time.





COMPUTER

A Computer Department with 40 computers at present provides the I.T. education to the students. Computer classes are compulsory for all students.



ACADEMY MESS

A fully modern well equipped Academy Mess with qualified staff provides hygienic food to the boarders. It has a spacious Dining hall which can seat 1000 in formal style on ceremonial occasions. Both vegetarian and non-vegetarian dishes are served to the teaching staff and students.



LANGUAGE LAB

To enable the students improve conversational skills, a fully equipped Language Lab is set up with a LCD Projector. Classes are brought regularly here to enhance English speaking ability.
